



PONYTAIL PROGRAM HALF-DAY PARTICIPANTS SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT NOTES – LAKE FOREST

- Our precious Ponytail half-day campers will attend from 9 a.m. until pick-up time which will be before or after lunch (your choice). Exact time TBD but around 11:30/12:00.
- Must be signed in each morning by an adult listed on their “Authorized List” in the Game On! Office. From the office they will be escorted to their team area to drop off their backpacks which should contain extra sunscreen for reapplication, a full water bottle, a nut-free snack with a zip lock bag for storing any uneaten portion and a nut-free lunch if they will be enjoying with camp.
- Lunch: Your campers have the option to join us for lunch as mentioned above. You must let us know via email if you plan on opting in for lunch.
- What to Pack: In addition to sunscreen, a water bottle, nut-free snack with plastic bag and nut-free lunch, we ask that you send your camper with an extra set of clothes, including underwear, in a zip lock bag to be kept with her belongings at all times in case of accidents.
- Field Trips: Lake Forest and Chicago campers will be attending a Chicago Sky Game on July 18th at 11 a.m. located at Wintrust Arena. Your camper is welcome but must be accompanied by an adult and is not permitted to ride the camp bus. Tickets for one adult and your camper are complimentary. If you would like extra tickets, you must purchase them from us in advance. You and your camper will of course be sitting with Game On!, though the accompanying adult is fully responsible for their camper.
- Pick Up: When picking up your Ponytail camper, you must come back to the camp office, search for the Director (who should be right on site) and sign her out, presenting a valid I.D. each time. In addition, the individual picking up must appear on your camper’s authorized pick up list.

Extra Notes

- If not being dropped off and picked up, sign in/sign out as described above does not apply
- Extra Field Trip: Our Lake Forest Campers will be traveling to our Chicago camp for one of the most fun days of the season: Carnival Day on July 10. Ponytail half day campers are more than welcome to attend if accompanied and driven both ways by an adult on their authorized list.
